7.00 a.m. Mass with Hymns 9.00 a.m. Sung High Mass

HELP IS REQUIRED:

On Saturday 24 March from 9.00 a.m. for the making of Palm Crosses. Donations of palm branches are required. The Flower Guild will be adorning the Church with palm branches for Palm Sunday. The Parish will provide tea and hot cross buns to all the workers.

So far 14 people have volunteered to from an augmented choir for Palm Sunday and Easter Sunday. There will be a rehearsal on Saturday 24 at 11.00 a.m. in the Church. There is plenty of space for more people to join.

For the Good Friday Three Hour Devotion we will be doing something different. An eight part reflection called The Nail, in which key witnesses e.g. Peter, Pilate, the Roman Centurion; Mary Magdalene etc. describe Christ's crucifixion from their point of view. The duration will be anything from two to three hours, so please come at the beginning at 12.00 Noon.

EASTER OFFERING

As I mentioned in my previous Rector's Letter St Cyprian's celebrates 150 years of ministry in Durban in 2020. The interior of the Church was last painted in 1995 when we celebrated the 125th anniversary. The paint has worn well, however, it does need to be painted again which we are planning to do towards the end of 2019 or the beginning of 2020.

The contractor who painted the Church in 1995 has quoted R266 736 to paint the entire interior of the Church. This would be an extraordinary expense and to begin a specific fund for this expense I would like our Easter Offering contribution to launch this project. I would ask that we give generously to the Easter Offering for this project.
